
Did you know that "flushable" does NOT mean "flushable"?

The toilets in our homes are designed to accept water, human waste, toilet paper, **AND NOTHING ELSE!** Many other items are advertised as "flushable", but when they are flushed down the toilet they don't disintegrate. They can plug up house drains, service lines, sewer mains, pumps, and treatment facilities. This causes backups that are expensive to clean up, and increases the maintenance costs for the public sewer system. To avoid these problems, remember, your "flushables" belong in the trash, not the sewer!
